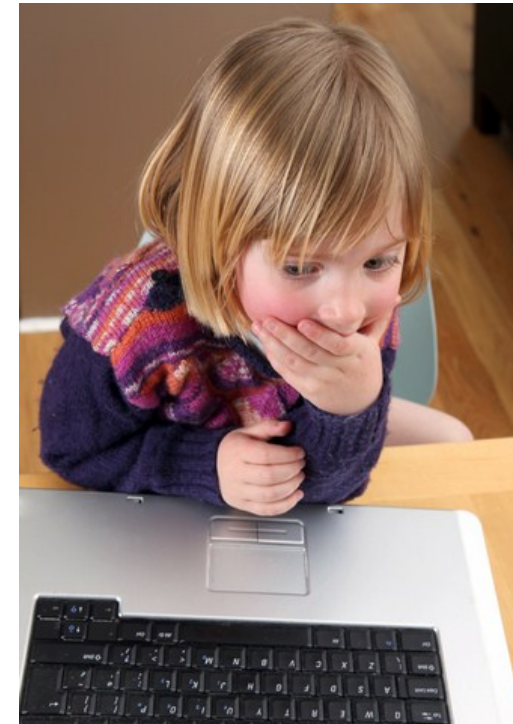

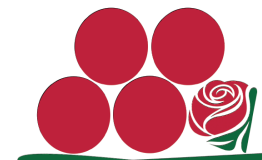

Professor Dr Christian Pfeiffer, Director of KFN, Hannover, an interdisciplinary research institute whose research teams have investigated (among many other projects), over a number of years, various aspects of media use and their effects on recipients. One of these projects is 'Media Use and School Achievement'.

The aim of this interdisciplinary research project was to investigate the consequences of intensive and increasingly uncontrolled television, computer and video game use by children and adolescents. A representative survey was designed to broadly examine how media usage can affect children and adolescents in their leisure time behaviour, their social behaviour and their school performance.

Meet the Speakers



Professor Carl Parsons is visiting Professor in Social Inclusion Studies at the Research Centre for Children, Schools and Families, University of Greenwich, London. He has published numerous articles and is the author of books about the exclusion of pupils from school. His experience has convinced him that schools which meet the wider needs of families and communities offer the best support and preventative work for pupils with behavior or psychological problems. He will examine the best (and worst) practice from Europe and America. His most recent publication is *Strategic Alternatives to Exclusion from School* (2009).



Barbara Schindelhauer leads the *ifvl* (Institute for Preschool Learning) and its nationwide advisory team in Germany. With their slogan 'early learning from a child's perspective', they have devised hands-on seminar ideas to develop and teach educational concepts, especially designed for early childhood needs. Barbara Schindelhauer is co-author of various publications, notably *Numberland*. The very positive experience of her two children with the *Numberland* concept made her want to help spread it nationwide. She will introduce her subject in a presentation at the general Session, then will offer a Workshop for those who would like to know more and try her ideas in a 'hands on' session.
